## Church Conference Called for February 4

An Advent UMC Church Conference has been called today at 12:00 noon, to be held in the church sanctuary. The purpose of the conference is to allow the Advent congregation to decide if the church should separate from the South Carolina Annual Conference or remain a United Methodist congregation. All professing members of Advent who are present may vote. Under the rules established by the South Carolina Conference of the UMC, absentee and proxy voting are not allowed.

Registration for voting will begin at 11:15AM in The Zone. Each professing member who comes to register will be asked to sign beside their name where it is listed on the roll, and will receive a ballot and a wristband showing that they have registered. Each person is responsible to keep their ballot, as no replacement ballots can be provided. Everyone in line by 12:00PM (Noon) will be allowed to register.

We will ask for a picture ID from each person who comes to register to vote. Government, work, or student IDs will be accepted. For youth who do not have a picture ID, a parent can vouch for their identification.
