3. What do you think Pastor Michael was talking about when he said, “Today you will learn the secret?”
4. The 1 Timothy 6:17-19 passage (NIV translation) ends with, “In this way they will lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age, so that they may take hold of the life that is truly life.” What do you think Paul meant by “life that is truly life?”
5. In the 1 Timothy 6:17-19 passage Paul shares several things that we can do that can help us to experience “life that is truly life.” What are some of these practices?
6. Pastor Michael shared a quote from Socrates which stated, “The richest man is not he who has the most, but he who needs the least.” What does that mean to you?
7. Pastor Michael closed his sermon with a “Love thy neighbor as thyself challenge.” What was this challenging us to do, and how might we personally meet this challenge?
